Hands-on training with immediate retesting ensures participants demonstrate competency before completing each session.

Specialization certifications integrate multiple courses into cohesive pathways. These programs require practical assessments rather than relying solely on written evaluations, enabling clinicians to translate new techniques directly into improved patient care. In addition to formal courses, the Institute of Clinical Excellence produces the #PTonICE Daily Show podcast, which releases episodes five days a week covering clinical application, research updates, and professional development topics. The organization also sends the Hump Day Hustling weekly email, which curates recent research articles and social media insights for its community.
