The craftsmanship involved in these items is labor-intensive and requires a level of skill that is becoming increasingly rare. Hand-side-stitching, for example, is a technique used to secure the mattress's outer borders to the internal spring unit.

This process can take several hours per piece and uses long needles and natural twine. The result is a mattress that provides edge-to-edge support without the need for thick foam encasements, which are known to trap heat and degrade over time. By focusing on these time-honored methods, the industry addresses the demand for products that are both functional and durable.

Sustainability also plays a significant role in the ongoing development of the luxury mattress in the Coronado landscape. As awareness of environmental impact grows, more people are seeking household items that are biodegradable and free of harsh chemical fire retardants.
