



## **Mountaintop Web Design Partners With Dr. Sam Haider on Website Launch**

The project emerged from the need to establish a professional online presence for a newly launched neurosurgery practice. Mountaintop Web Design led strategy, design, and development throughout the engagement, working closely with Dr. Haider to ensure the finished site reflected the values and tone of a physician-led practice built around individualized and patient-centered care.

"Launching a new neurosurgery practice in Greeley meant I needed a website that truly reflects who I am and how I care for patients," Dr. Haider said. "The team at Mountaintop didn't just build a website ? they took the time to understand my vision and what my practice stands for. They were collaborative, responsive, and felt like real teammates throughout the entire process."

Dr. Haider completed advanced neurosurgical fellowship training at the University of Miami, one of the highest-volume brain tumor centers in the country, and at Henry Ford Health in Detroit, a Level-1 trauma center. Over the course of his career, he has performed more than 2,000 neurosurgical procedures. His practice treats a wide spectrum of brain, spine, and nerve conditions, with a clinical emphasis on minimally invasive approaches and shared decision-making with patients.

Mountaintop Web Design structured the site with attention to how patients navigate medical information during periods of uncertainty. The content architecture was designed to guide visitors through information about conditions, procedures, and the consultation process in a clear and approachable way, avoiding clinical jargon that can obscure rather than inform. According to Mountaintop Web Design, the goal was to ensure first-time visitors could quickly understand what the practice offers and what to expect when requesting a consultation.

"A medical practice website has to do something very specific. It has to communicate trust before a patient ever walks through the door," said Josiah Bussing, CEO of Mountaintop Web Design. "With Dr. Haider, we had a clear picture of who he is as a physician and how he approaches his patients. Our job was to translate that into a digital experience that reflects his values and feels accessible to anyone visiting the site for the first time."

The project also prioritized mobile performance and cross-device consistency. As patient behavior increasingly shifts toward mobile-first browsing, Mountaintop Web Design built the site to deliver a reliable experience regardless of how visitors access it. The agency noted that for service-based medical practices, mobile usability is essential to meeting the expectations of a modern patient audience.

Dr. Haider's practice operates through the Banner Health Clinic in Greeley and serves patients across Northern Colorado and surrounding areas. The website was developed to reflect the scope and credibility of the practice while presenting Dr. Haider's background and clinical philosophy in a manner accessible to a general audience. Mountaintop Web Design indicated that presenting medical credentials with accuracy while maintaining readability for non-clinical visitors was a central consideration throughout the project.

The website is now live and accessible to the public. Dr. Haider's practice intends to use the platform as a central resource for patient education, appointment requests, and general inquiries, with updates expected as the practice continues to grow.
