Patient education forms a central component of the new protocol, with standardized consultation procedures that explain the conservative approach and set appropriate expectations for gradual, natural-looking improvements. The protocol requires providers to discuss treatment timelines that often span multiple sessions rather than seeking maximum results in single appointments. This educational component helps patients understand the value of patience in achieving optimal aesthetic outcomes.

The clinical treatment planning protocol extends beyond facial injectables to include body contouring procedures and skin rejuvenation treatments offered at the practice.
