If left unaddressed, cocaine-related kidney damage follows a predictable and increasingly severe trajectory. From acute kidney injury, which can develop within hours, to chronic kidney disease, and ultimately to end-stage renal failure requiring dialysis or transplant. With synthetic cutting agents like levamisole becoming more prevalent in the U.S. cocaine supply, the risk of immune-related kidney inflammation is expanding even among occasional users. The window for intervention and for meaningful recovery of kidney function narrows with every episode of use. Early treatment saves kidneys. It also saves lives.
