



Alpha Plumbing, Heating & Cooling Introduces Royalty Home Club Membership Program

Alpha Plumbing, Heating & Cooling has introduced the Royalty Home Club membership program for homeowners in the Twin Cities area. The program establishes a structured approach to annual maintenance of residential plumbing, heating, and cooling systems. Membership provides a dedicated framework for ongoing system care amid Minnesota's seasonal climate variations.

The Royalty Home Club includes one plumbing home inspection per year. During this inspection, technicians perform a water heater drain and flush to remove sediment accumulation. They also conduct a water quality test and a safety gas sweep to evaluate gas lines and related components. These steps allow for documentation of system conditions at regular intervals.

The membership program differs from standard service calls by incorporating this scheduled annual inspection as a core element. Standard service remains available on an as-needed basis for installations, repairs, and emergencies, while the Royalty Home Club adds the recurring inspection to the service options.

Plumbing services in Bloomington, MN, cover fixture installations, including faucets, sinks, toilets, and

showerheads. Piping work addresses water supply and waste lines. Repairs handle leaks, burst pipes, garbage disposal issues, and water heater malfunctions. Remodel services adjust plumbing configurations during bathroom or kitchen renovations to meet current code requirements. Emergency responses address urgent problems such as flooding or severe leaks.

Water heater services include installation, repair, and replacement to support consistent hot water availability. Gas services encompass line installations, appliance hookups for stoves, ovens, and dryers, leak detection through pressure testing, and system maintenance. Drain services involve cleaning of kitchen and bathroom drains, sewer line inspections with camera technology, pipe repairs, hydro-jetting for blockages, trenchless replacements to minimize excavation, tree root removal, and backflow prevention with testing.

Heating services focus on furnace repairs and maintenance following periods of extended use. Cooling services address air conditioning repairs to prepare units for warmer months. Technicians aim to complete most repairs during the first visit when parts and conditions allow. Free estimates are offered for new heating and cooling system installations.

A one-year warranty applies to parts and labor for all completed work. Pricing follows an upfront quote model, so costs are known before any work proceeds.

Customer reviews provide accounts of service experiences. One reviewer described a pipe repair in which the technician explained the process and offered maintenance advice. Another noted a thorough heating system inspection that included details on components and monitoring suggestions. A third account mentioned next-day scheduling for furnace maintenance. Additional feedback highlighted a water heater replacement combined with main shut-off valve installation and kitchen plumbing adjustments during a renovation, with observations on part quality and responsiveness.

These reviews illustrate interactions with technicians during both standard calls and maintenance-related visits. The company has served residential customers across the region for several years, though exact membership enrollment numbers are not publicly specified.

"The Royalty Home Club establishes a routine for annual system checks that standard service calls do not include on a scheduled basis," said Chad Olson, owner of Plumber at Alpha Plumbing, Heating & Cooling. "The inspection covers specific tasks such as the water heater flush and gas sweep to track conditions over time."

"Membership adds the structured inspection while standard services continue to handle repairs and emergencies as they arise," continued Olson. "This combination provides options for different maintenance approaches."
