The company has responded to multiple emergency situations in recent weeks, including one Concord homeowner who discovered four inches of standing water in their basement and another Franklin resident whose furnace was destroyed when their sump pump failed during overnight rainfall. These incidents highlight the critical importance of sump pump maintenance before the peak flooding season arrives.

"We see this pattern every spring when homeowners discover their sump pumps have failed at the worst possible moment," said Stephen Keane, spokesperson at RestoPros of Southern New Hampshire. "A simple test run and basic maintenance in March can prevent thousands of dollars in water heater leak damage repair costs and protect irreplaceable family belongings. The difference between catching a problem early and dealing with a flooded basement is often just a matter of hours."

The restoration company emphasizes that sump pump failures account for a substantial portion of residential water damage claims during spring months. Common causes include power outages, mechanical wear, clogged discharge lines, and overwhelmed systems during heavy rainfall events. Many homeowners remain unaware that their sump pump has failed until water begins accumulating in their basement.

RestoPros technicians recommend homeowners test their sump pumps monthly by pouring water into the pit to ensure proper activation and drainage. Additional preventive measures include checking the power source, clearing debris from the pit, inspecting the discharge line for freezing or blockages, and considering battery backup systems for power outage protection.

The company maintains round-the-clock emergency response teams equipped to handle everything from minor seepage to major flooding events. Their certified technicians provide immediate water extraction, structural drying, and complete drywall water damage restoration services.
