AnDi's Pet Perimeters Marks 25 Years in Pet Containment Business

AnDi's Pet Perimeters has reached 25 years in the pet containment business as of April. The company has provided underground electric dog fence installation, training, and repair services to families across central and west central Minnesota throughout that period.

The milestone reflects sustained operation since the company began offering containment solutions in April two and a half decades ago. During these 25 years, AnDi's Pet Perimeters has installed numerous buried wire systems that create defined safe areas for dogs on residential properties. These systems rely on a signal transmitted through a wire buried along the chosen boundary path. The dog's receiver collar detects the signal as the pet approaches the edge, first delivering an audible warning tone. If the dog continues forward and crosses the boundary, the collar activates a mild static correction. The intensity of this correction is adjusted individually for each dog according to its size, breed, and temperament to ensure an appropriate response.

Installation begins with a review of the property layout to determine the most suitable loop configuration. Three primary options exist. A perimeter loop follows the entire outer boundary of the property. An hourglass

loop divides the front yard from the back yard while still allowing controlled access between them. A double loop encloses or partitions off specific sections, such as the front yard or backyard only. Once the configuration is selected, the signal wire is buried at an appropriate depth and connected to the transmitter. Temporary flags are placed along the boundary line during the first phase of training to give the dog a clear visual reference for the limits of the safe area.

While some pet owners consider alternatives such as the wireless dog fence for their properties, AnDi's Pet Perimeters has maintained its focus on professionally installed buried wire systems that align with the varied terrain and lot sizes common in central and west central Minnesota. The approach requires precise placement of the wire to maintain consistent signal strength across the entire designated zone. Over the course of 25 years, the company has addressed a wide range of property challenges, from open rural lots to more compact suburban settings.

Training constitutes an essential component of every installation. The GentleSteps program involves on-site sessions led by certified trainers that typically extend over one to two weeks. The curriculum centers on positive reinforcement techniques that incorporate verbal praise and rewards to encourage the dog to remain within the approved area. Any corrective elements are kept to a minimum and are applied in a humane manner consistent with the dog's learning pace. Trainers work directly with both the pet and the owner throughout the process to build reliable habits. Following the conclusion of the formal on-site period, phone and text support remains available to owners who have questions or need guidance as they continue reinforcing the training at home. This structured sequence helps dogs associate the boundary with positive experiences rather than solely with correction.

The receiver collars integrated into the system weigh only 0.9 ounces to minimize any burden on the dog during daily wear. There are two options for receivers: a battery-operated option, which requires battery replacements every 6 to 8 months. There are also 2 options when it comes to the rechargeable receivers, both capable of providing up to three weeks of operation between charges, and they also employ diagnostic testing features. Waterproof construction allows the collars to withstand outdoor conditions, including rain and snow common in Minnesota seasons. The collars connect via Bluetooth and WIFI to a dedicated mobile application that enables owners and their dealer to monitor system status and make setting adjustments as needed. Probes attached to the collars are selected and fitted for comfort based on the individual dog's coat and skin sensitivity.

Warranties accompany the installed systems. Coverage periods range from two years on standard components to lifetime options on select components, which include transmitters and receiver collars. In addition to new installations, the company maintains capabilities to perform repairs on existing underground dog fence systems. Selected Systems employ Smart Link Bluetooth and WIF technology to alert the pet owner and dealer of breaks in the wire or other equipment faults efficiently. This repair service helps extend

the functional life of systems that have been in place for many years.

Andrew Olson, Owner of AnDi's Pet Perimeters, stated, "Reaching 25 years in this field has allowed the accumulation of extensive experience with different properties and dogs across central Minnesota, which informs each new installation and training plan."

Olson continued, "The consistent application of professional installation methods combined with the GentleSteps training approach has supported effective containment outcomes for many families over this period."
