

Alight ABA Expands Access to In-Home ABA Therapy Services Across North Carolina

These plans focus on key areas such as communication, social interaction, daily living skills, and behavior management. Therapy is delivered by trained Registered Behavior Technicians (RBTs) under the supervision

of BCBA's, ensuring that services remain consistent, data-driven, and responsive to progress over time. This layered clinical structure helps maintain quality and accountability while allowing for frequent, hands-on interaction between therapists and children.

One of the defining aspects of Alight ABA's approach is the emphasis on real-world application. By working within the home environment, therapists can address behaviors and skill development in the contexts where they naturally occur, such as mealtime routines, play activities, and transitions between daily tasks. This allows for more effective generalization of skills, as children learn to apply what they practice during therapy to everyday interactions with family members and within their routines. Over time, this approach helps bridge the gap between structured therapy and independent functioning.
