



## **Modern Vision Solutions Publishes Eyeglass Frame Selection Guidance for Omaha Residents**

Modern Vision Solutions, an optometrist located in Omaha, Nebraska, has published a new educational article addressing the most common mistakes patients make when selecting eyeglass frames. The article, titled "Finding Glasses That Actually Look Like You: How Modern Vision Solutions Helps Omaha Residents," examines why many eyeglass wearers end up with frames that correct their vision but do not suit their face, lifestyle, or personal style. The piece is the latest installment in a series of patient education resources published by the Omaha optometry practice for area residents researching eyeglasses, contact lenses, and broader eye care online.

The article identifies several recurring patterns behind poor frame outcomes in the Omaha eyewear market and beyond. According to the article, high-volume optical retailers often run back-to-back appointments that leave limited time for frame consultation, and large frame walls can lead shoppers toward conservative defaults rather than styles that fit their face shape and coloring. Online try-on tools, the article notes, cannot show how a frame's temple sits behind the ear, whether the nose bridge fits an individual's actual nose, or whether the frame is comfortable for full-day wear. The article also addresses the role of face shape, skin undertones, hair color, frame material, and daily routine in selecting eyeglasses, noting that titanium frames

offer a lighter alternative for patients who find traditional plastic frames uncomfortable by mid-afternoon. The article further raises the idea that frame preferences may shift over time, and that eyeglasses no longer reflecting a wearer's current life stage can be a reasonable signal to consider a new pair.

Eyeglass patients in the Omaha area can complete frame selection during the same appointment as the practice's VisionTrack EyeAnalysis exam, with adjustments to temple length, nose placement, and overall frame balance handled in-office. Frame selection at the Omaha location is conducted under what the practice calls its No-Pressure Promise, a stated policy that the optical team will not steer patients toward higher-margin frames or contact lenses. The location carries a curated frame collection that includes lightweight titanium options, prescription sunglasses, designer everyday frames, and performance eyewear for athletes, with options offered at a range of price points.

"Most of the frame regret we see comes down to two things: patients shopping somewhere that didn't have time to help them, or relying on a screen that can't show how a frame actually fits," said Dr. Meagan Anderson, OD, optometrist at Modern Vision Solutions in Omaha. "Frame selection involves face shape, skin undertones, frame weight, and the way someone actually moves through their day. When those factors are considered together, patients end up with eyeglasses they want to wear, not just ones they need to wear." Dr. Anderson holds a Doctor of Optometry degree from the University of Missouri ? St. Louis College of Optometry and completed her residency in Refractive Surgery and Primary Care at Kugler Vision in Omaha. She earned her undergraduate degree from the University of Nebraska Omaha and is a member of the American Optometric Association, the American Academy of Optometry, and the Nebraska Optometric Association.

Modern Vision Solutions is located at 10345 Pacific St, Omaha, NE 68114, and serves eyeglasses, contact lens, and comprehensive eye exam patients throughout Omaha, West Omaha, Papillion, La Vista, Bellevue, and Council Bluffs. On-site adjustments to temple length, nose-pad position, and overall frame balance are part of the standard fitting process at the Omaha location.
