



# All In Tree Service of Hiram Shares 2026 Georgia Stump Grinding Cost Guide for Homeowners in Hiram and Paulding County

According to the company's newly published 2026 pricing guide, most homeowners in Georgia pay between \$100 and \$400 per stump for professional stump grinding. Smaller stumps may cost less, while larger stumps, hardwood species, difficult access, and deeper grinding requests can push pricing higher. The company says stump diameter remains the biggest pricing factor, and many stump grinding companies in Georgia, including providers in the Hiram area, commonly use a per-inch pricing model combined with a minimum service charge.

“After a tree is removed, the stump becomes the next problem homeowners want to solve quickly,” said Rudy Perez, owner of All In Tree Services and Pro. “What many people do not realize is that stump grinding price depends on more than just the stump itself. Size, wood type, roots, access, and cleanup all play a role.”

The company’s pricing guide breaks stump grinding cost into practical size categories that homeowners can understand. Small stumps between 6 and 12 inches often fall in the \$75 to \$150 range. Medium stumps from 12 to 24 inches usually cost \$150 to \$300. Large stumps between 24 and 36 inches can range from \$250 to \$450, while extra-large stumps above 36 inches may run \$400 to \$700 or more, depending on site conditions and difficulty.

For homeowners searching “stump grinding cost Hiram GA” or “how much to remove a stump in Georgia,” the company says one of the most important things to understand is the minimum charge. Even a small stump may still cost \$100 to \$150 because the crew must transport specialized grinding equipment, set up safely, and complete cleanup. That minimum charge is common in the industry and often explains why a simple online per-inch estimate does not match a real quote on site.

All In Tree Service of Hiram also explains how per-inch stump grinding pricing works in Georgia. In many cases, the stump is measured across its widest point, and the cost may run between \$2 and \$5 per inch depending on the tree species and access. A 20-inch stump may appear inexpensive on paper using a low per-inch rate, but if the result falls below the company minimum, the homeowner will still pay the minimum service price. That pricing structure becomes more favorable when multiple stumps are ground during the same visit, because bulk pricing can lower the average cost per stump.

The company says several property-specific issues can also affect the final quote for stump grinding in Hiram and Paulding County. Hardwood species such as oak, maple, and hickory take longer to grind and create more wear on the equipment than softer species. Large root flares, uneven grade, narrow backyard gates, nearby fences, retaining walls, and close proximity to foundations can all increase labor time and difficulty. If a homeowner requests deeper grinding to prepare for replanting, sod installation, or hardscaping, that can also raise the price.

“Not all stumps are equal, even if they look similar from the street,” Perez said. “A stump in an open front yard is much easier than a hardwood stump behind a fence line with exposed roots and limited machine access. That is why on-site estimates matter.”

The company also uses the guide to explain the difference between stump grinding and full stump removal, which are often confused in online searches. Stump grinding cuts the stump below grade and allows the remaining root system to decay naturally over time. Full stump removal involves pulling out the stump and

root ball entirely, usually with larger equipment, which creates more damage to the yard and generally costs much more. According to the company, professional stump grinding in Georgia typically ranges from \$100 to \$400, while full stump removal can run \$300 to \$800 or more depending on root size and excavation needs.

For most residential properties in Hiram, stump grinding is usually the better value. It removes the visible stump, improves the look of the yard, reduces tripping hazards, and restores usable lawn space without the larger excavation footprint associated with full removal. The company says full removal is generally best reserved for construction prep, major landscaping changes, or situations where the root system is causing structural problems.

Old stumps can attract insects, interfere with mowing, create trip hazards, and make landscaping projects harder to finish.
