The dealership in Gambrills stocks Super C models such as the Thor Motor Coach Magnitude series, built on Ford F-550 or F-600 chassis with 6.7-liter Power Stroke V8 turbo diesel engines.

Super C diesel motorhomes feature a commercial truck cab integrated with a Class C-style coach. This design incorporates manufacturer-specified safety elements associated with the truck chassis, including the engine positioned ahead of the cab. Industry comparisons note that this front-engine layout provides a protective structure in front-end scenarios, differing from flat-nose designs in some other motorhome classes.

Separate driver and passenger doors in the cab permit direct access to the exterior. This configuration supports inspections of tires, hitch connections, or other components during travel stops without requiring

passage through the coach interior.

Towing capacities for these models are defined by manufacturer specifications. Thor Motor Coach Magnitude units typically include trailer hitches rated at 10,000 to 12,000 pounds, with gross combined weight ratings reaching up to 43,000 pounds depending on the specific chassis and layout. These ratings enable towing of additional vehicles or equipment within the limits set by the chassis manufacturer.

Highway performance characteristics derive from the truck-chassis platform. The chassis provides a wheelbase and suspension designed for stability at cruising speeds. Owner and product reviews describe handling consistent with the underlying Ford truck engineering.

Engine service access stems from the front-mounted diesel powertrain. The truck cab design allows mechanics or owners to reach the engine compartment from the front, following standard truck service procedures rather than configurations that require interior access.

Bob Wilson, General Manager of Leo's, went on to say, "My points of interest in Super C diesel motorhomes were the safety provided by the truck front, the convenience of separate cab doors for exterior checks without walking through the coach, strong tow capacity, solid driving and handling at highway speeds, and straightforward engine service access for personal maintenance."

These attributes reflect a combination of manufacturer specifications from chassis and coach builders, customer feedback reported to dealership staff, and observations drawn from industry product analyses. While Type C motorhome shipments have shown variability month to month, the segment has contributed to overall motorhome growth in 2025 and early 2026, according to RV Industry Association reports.

Leo's Vacation Center maintains an inventory of new and used Super C diesel motorhomes featuring different floor plans, slide-outs, and sleeping accommodations. Sales staff provide details on chassis ratings, interior configurations, and powertrain specifications to assist customers in evaluating suitability for their travel needs.
