"Dentists see anatomical structures and wear patterns that directly correlate with sleep-disordered breathing," said Anne Hertzberg, D.M.D., from the Chestnut Dental Office. "During regular checkups, we observe signs like enamel erosion from nighttime grinding, jaw muscle tension, and airway characteristics that suggest

potential breathing disruptions during sleep. These observations allow us to initiate important conversations about sleep health and recommend appropriate evaluation."

Sleep apnea affects an estimated 22 million Americans, according to the American Sleep Apnea Association, with approximately 80 percent of moderate and severe cases remaining undiagnosed. The condition, characterized by repeated interruptions in breathing during sleep, can lead to serious health complications including cardiovascular disease, diabetes, and cognitive impairment when left untreated.

Dental professionals are uniquely positioned to observe early warning signs of sleep-disordered breathing during routine examinations. Common oral indicators include worn tooth surfaces from grinding, scalloped tongue edges, enlarged tonsils, and specific jaw positioning patterns. These physical manifestations often appear before patients seek medical evaluation for sleep concerns.

The integration of sleep health awareness into dental practice represents an evolution in comprehensive patient care. While dentists do not diagnose sleep apnea independently, their observations can prompt referrals for sleep studies and collaboration with sleep medicine physicians. For confirmed cases, dental professionals may provide oral appliance therapy as part of a coordinated Sleep Apnea treatment plan.

The dental community's involvement in sleep health screening addresses a significant gap in healthcare delivery. Many individuals visit their dentist more frequently than their primary care physician, creating regular opportunities for observation and early intervention. This accessibility makes dental practices valuable frontline resources for identifying potential sleep disorders.
