



Full Mouth Dental Implants Pimlico Victoria London Dentist Recommends Treatment Consultations for Missing Teeth at McKennell Dental Practice

McKennell Dental Practice remarks that when planning All-On-4 dental implants, the dentist takes into account the patient's jawbone structure and overall oral health. This approach is often used when a person is missing several teeth or when traditional removable dentures don't give them the level of stability they require. The dental team commented that the idea is to examine each case separately because the results can be different depending on the varying clinical factors.

Consultations at McKennell Dental Practice generally begin with a review of dental history and an examination of the mouth. This may include assessing gum health and the amount of bone available to support implants. Imaging or digital scans are often used to build a clearer picture of the patient's dental structure, allowing the dentist to outline potential treatment options.

During the consultation, patients are able to discuss how full mouth dental implants are planned and what the process may involve. This includes information about treatment stages, recovery considerations, and the long-term maintenance required to support implant health. The practice noted that suitability is determined on a case-by-case basis, and alternative approaches may be discussed where appropriate.

Broader research has also highlighted the importance of careful planning and follow-up in implant dentistry. A 2024 study titled "How far can we go? A 20-year meta-analysis of dental implant survival rates", published in Clinical Oral Investigations and coordinated in Mainz, Germany, reported that around four out of five dental implants remain successful over time. Conducted by Kupka JR, König J, Al-Nawas B, Sagheb K, and Schiegnitz E, the research also noted that implant loss can occur for a range of reasons, underlining the need for ongoing monitoring and adherence to established clinical standards to support consistent long-term outcomes.

McKennell Dental Practice offers a range of dental implant procedures to help with different levels of tooth loss. One of these is the All-On-4 dental implant, which completely replaces the full arch of teeth. Based on individual conditions, patients may be recommended a single dental implant to replace one missing tooth, or multiple implants to support bridges where several teeth are missing. Both methods work on the same idea: dental implants act like artificial roots that hold up replacement teeth above the gum line.

The dental team explained that consultations are structured to provide a clear comparison between these

treatment options. Factors such as bone density, gum condition, and general oral health are considered when determining which approach may be suitable. In some cases, preparatory procedures may be discussed if additional support is required before implants can be placed.

McKennell Dental Practice also noted that consultation appointments are arranged to allow time for patients to ask questions and consider their options carefully. This can be particularly important for individuals who may feel uncertain about implant treatment or who have not previously explored long-term solutions for missing teeth. Clear explanations are provided throughout the consultation process so that expectations remain realistic.

Patients in Pimlico, Victoria, and the surrounding areas in London can get dental care and consultation appointments at the practice. Before any treatment is planned, routine dental checkups may be done along with consultations for implants to make sure that the patient's overall oral health is checked. This method helps people make informed choices and aims to keep both function and comfort over time.
