## **All Pro Thornton Deck Builders Expands Deck Repair Program**

Contractor adds year-round deck repair and restoration services across 14 Colorado communities.

All Pro Thornton Deck Builders announced the expansion of its deck repair and restoration program to serve homeowners year-round across 14 communities in the northern Denver metropolitan area. The expanded program, now available in cities from Aurora to Westminster, provides structural assessments, board replacement, and full surface refinishing for wood, composite, and PVC decking systems.

The expansion responds to growing demand for professional deck maintenance in a region where seasonal weather patterns cause accelerated wear on outdoor structures. According to the company, the average deck repair costs approximately \$2,000, and most projects are completed within two to four hours. All Pro Thornton Deck Builders has performed deck repair and restoration work throughout Adams and Weld counties for more than a decade, handling everything from joist reinforcement and board replacement to pressure washing and sealant application.

"We built this company on the idea that homeowners deserve a deck contractor who treats repair work with

the same care as new construction," said David Miller, Owner of All Pro Thornton Deck Builders. "A lot of people put off deck repair and restoration because they think it means tearing everything out and starting over. In most cases, targeted repairs extend a deck's life by ten to fifteen years at a fraction of the replacement cost."

The program covers traditional wood decks, which typically require structural attention every 10 to 15 years, as well as capped polymer decking that can last up to 50 years with proper upkeep. Each project begins with a multi-point inspection that checks for mold, pest damage, and compromised joists before any work begins. All Pro Thornton Deck Builders is licensed, bonded, and insured to operate as a deck contractor in the state of Colorado, and all repairs are completed in compliance with local building codes.

Colorado's front range climate presents distinct challenges for outdoor wood and composite structures. Wide temperature swings between seasons, intense UV exposure at elevation, and freeze-thaw cycles during winter months can loosen fasteners, warp boards, and accelerate wood rot in deck joists and substructures. The company noted that many of the repair calls it receives involve damage that began as minor surface issues but progressed to structural concerns after one or two seasons without maintenance.

The deck restoration process employed by the company follows a ten-step protocol. Technicians begin by extracting loose or corroded fasteners, then inspect each joist for rot using moisture meters and visual assessment. Weakened joists are reinforced through a technique known as sistering, in which a new support board is secured alongside the compromised member using galvanized nails or structural screws. Damaged deck boards are then cut and replaced to match the existing layout, and the entire surface is pressure-washed, sanded, and treated with wood preservative or sealant to protect against future moisture penetration.

"What sets a proper deck restoration apart from a quick patch job is the structural work underneath the surface," said Miller. "We check every railing post, every stair stringer, and every ledger board connection before we move on to cosmetic repairs. Homeowners should not have to wonder whether their deck is safe to walk on after a contractor leaves."

The deck repair and restoration program operates alongside the company's other service lines, which include custom deck design and installation, porch construction, pool deck building, patio and hardscape work, and shade structure and pergola installation. All Pro Thornton Deck Builders uses materials from suppliers, including Trex and Azek, and its team holds current licensing and insurance credentials required by the state of Colorado for exterior residential construction.
