



## **Evergreen Landscape Pros Extends Service Area to La Española**

Evergreen Landscape Pros will offer landscape design, hardscape construction, irrigation, and property maintenance to residential and commercial clients in the Española Valley.

Evergreen Landscape Pros, a landscaping company based in Santa Fe, has expanded its service area to include La Española, New Mexico, and neighboring communities in the Española Valley. The expansion adds residential and commercial landscaping options to a region that sits roughly 25 miles north of Santa Fe and has seen steady growth in recent years.

The company, headquartered at 105 Cienega Street, Suite #110 in Santa Fe, provides landscape design, installation, ongoing maintenance, hardscape and stonework construction, irrigation system management, and fencing. These services are now available to property owners in the Española area under the same structure the company has used across Santa Fe County since its founding.

La Española is located where Santa Fe County meets Rio Arriba County, positioned between Santa Fe and Taos and approximately 30 minutes from Los Alamos. The area was originally settled in 1598 as San Gabriel,

making it the site of the first European settlement in what is now the United States. It was formally incorporated and renamed Española in 1925.

The valley is home to several notable historical and cultural sites, including the Puye Cliff Dwellings, a National Historic Landmark with cave and surface dwellings dating from 900 to 1580, and the Los Luceros Historic Site, which features a 5,700-square-foot 18th-century adobe home listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The community reflects a blend of Native American and Hispanic cultural traditions that shape the region's architecture, cuisine, and public life.

"We've been hearing from homeowners and business owners in the Española area who were looking for landscaping support closer to home," said the Evergreen Landscape Pros team. "Adding the valley to our service area was a natural next step."

Landscaping in the Española Valley involves a specific set of environmental factors. The area sits at roughly 5,600 feet in elevation, receives limited annual rainfall, and experiences wide temperature swings between summer and winter. These conditions affect everything from plant selection to irrigation scheduling and hardscape material durability. Evergreen Landscape Pros has worked in similar conditions throughout the Santa Fe area, where freeze-thaw cycles, alkaline soils, and water conservation are routine considerations in project planning.

Properties in and around La Española often reflect the area's long architectural history, from traditional adobe homes and portals to structures near historic pueblo sites. Outdoor spaces in this context tend to call for materials and design choices that are consistent with the surrounding landscape rather than imported from other regions. The company's existing work with coyote fencing, latilla construction, natural stone, and locally sourced plantings is aligned with the kinds of projects common in the valley.

Evergreen Landscape Pros sources plantings, stone, and building materials from Northern New Mexico suppliers when available. For Española-area projects, this means shrubs, trees, and flowers that are already acclimated to the valley's soil and climate, which generally reduces transplant loss and long-term maintenance needs. The company has maintained these supplier relationships across its existing Santa Fe County operations.

The company's Española-area services cover both residential and commercial properties. Residential work typically begins with a consultation to establish the property owner's goals and preferences before moving into design and installation. Commercial work focuses on scheduled property maintenance, grounds upkeep, and seasonal adjustments. Both tracks draw from the same service categories—landscape design, hardscape, irrigation, fencing, and ongoing maintenance—and can be combined depending on the scope of the project.

Evergreen Landscape Pros structures its projects around a consultation-first process. The company meets with the property owner before beginning work to discuss preferences, constraints, and priorities. The same team that handles the initial design and installation typically continues with ongoing maintenance, which the company says helps preserve the original intent of the landscape as it matures through different seasons.

With the addition of La Española, Evergreen Landscape Pros now serves communities across a broad section of Northern New Mexico. The company's service area includes Santa Fe, Eldorado at Santa Fe, Galisteo, Lamy, Pecos, Pojoaque, Seton Village, Tesuque, and White Rock, among others. The company has noted that it also takes on work outside its listed coverage area on a case-by-case basis.
