



Honey Sugaring and Facials Addresses Demand for Sugaring Hair Removal

The studio, which uses a sugaring paste made from natural ingredients to remove unwanted hair from the follicle, has reported increased appointment volume as more consumers seek sugaring techniques over traditional waxing and shaving.

The sugaring process involves applying a paste composed of sugar, water, and lemon to the skin, then removing it in the direction of hair growth. Unlike wax-based methods, which adhere to both hair and skin, the sugar paste bonds primarily to the hair and dead skin cells, functioning as a form of epilation that also exfoliates during the procedure. The sugaring for skin and sugaring for hair removal technique can be applied to multiple body areas including brazilian and bikini sugaring, underarms, legs, and facial hair removal. Among available sugaring methods, the hand-applied paste technique is performed by a trained esthetician in a sugaring salon setting.

According to Straits Research, the global market for sugaring was valued at \$2.74 billion in 2024 and is

projected to reach \$4.12 billion by 2032, growing at a compound annual growth rate of 5.21 percent. The growth reflects a broader industry shift toward beauty and skincare practices that prioritize sustainability and natural ingredients rather than chemical-based or resin-based formulations. The trend is particularly pronounced in North America, where the region holds the largest share of the global sugaring market.

The spa and salon industry overall has experienced sustained growth that supports the expansion of specialized services. According to a study commissioned by the International Spa Association and conducted by PricewaterhouseCoopers, the United States spa industry reached \$22.5 billion in revenue in 2024, with total spa visits increasing to 187 million. The number of spa locations nationwide grew to 21,980, suggesting continued consumer investment in professional skincare and hair removal treatments. The data indicates that sugaring body treatments and other natural services are among the categories driving appointment growth at independent esthetic studios.

Sugaring for skin and sugaring hair removal differ from shaving and razor-based methods in that it removes hair from the root rather than cutting it at the surface. This distinction in the sugaring process means that hair growth following a sugaring session typically takes longer to become visible compared to shaving, and the procedure is noted for addressing concerns common among individuals with sensitive skin, including irritation and ingrown hairs. The ancient technique, which traces its origins to practices documented in Egypt and Mesopotamia, has gained renewed attention from the dermatology and skincare community as consumers evaluate sugaring vs waxing and other hair removal options across various skin types. Because the sugaring paste contains only sugars, water, and lemon, it is water-soluble and can be cleaned from the skin without additional chemical solvents.
