



Dentures Coventry Private Dentist Dr Chetan Mathias Recommends Consultations for Missing Teeth at Light Lane Dental Practice

Light Lane Dental Practice has announced the availability of consultation appointments for patients considering dentures as a solution for missing teeth. The Coventry practice stated that the consultations are intended to help patients understand the different replacement options available while assessing comfort, appearance, and long-term function on an individual basis.

Missing teeth can affect more than appearance alone. Difficulties with chewing, changes in speech, and reduced confidence are among the concerns commonly discussed during consultations. According to the practice, dentures remain an established option for replacing missing teeth, particularly where patients are seeking removable restorations designed to restore everyday oral function.

Dentures are custom-made appliances used to replace several missing teeth or a complete arch. Partial dentures are designed for patients who still retain some natural teeth, while full dentures replace all teeth

within the upper or lower jaw. The practice explained that dentures are created to improve support for the cheeks and lips while helping patients regain clearer speech and more comfortable eating ability.

Consultations at Light Lane Dental Practice generally begin with a review of dental history and a discussion regarding the patient's concerns about missing teeth. Examinations are carried out to assess gum health, remaining teeth, and the overall condition of the mouth before recommendations are made. Impressions or scans may also be used as part of the planning stage to help ensure that dentures are designed to fit comfortably.

The practice noted that denture treatment can vary according to the number of teeth missing and the patient's long-term preferences. Some individuals may require a straightforward removable option, while others may wish to explore alternatives offering additional stability. During the consultation process, patients are informed about the expected adjustment period associated with new dentures, including changes in speech and chewing as the mouth adapts. Research has also underlined the importance of professionally designed dentures in supporting long-term comfort and function.

A study by Ribeiro, Resende, Lopes, Mestriner Júnior, Roncalli, Farias-Neto, and da Fonte Porto Carreiro titled 'Evaluation of Complete Denture Quality and Masticatory Efficiency in Denture Wearers?', published in the International Journal of Prosthodontics in 2012, reported that well-fitting dentures can contribute to improved chewing ability, greater stability, and increased patient satisfaction when maintained through appropriate professional dental care.

Light Lane Dental Practice has served the Coventry community with family dentistry, including both private and NHS care, for more than 40 years. The practice stated that discussions relating to missing teeth are approached carefully, particularly for patients who may have experienced long periods without dental treatment. Appointments are arranged to allow time for questions, helping patients understand the different pathways available before making decisions about treatment.

Apart from dentures, the practice also offers other missing teeth treatments, including single dental implants and All-On-4 dental implants. A popular option for replacing individual missing teeth, dental implants involve surgically placing a small titanium post into the jawbone, which then supports a replacement crown. On the other hand, the All-On-4 implants are used when a patient is missing multiple teeth, and is interested in replacing a full arch of teeth.

The practice also explained that All-On-4 dental implants are available for patients requiring complete arch replacement. This treatment uses a limited number of implants to support a full arch of fixed replacement teeth. Unlike removable dentures, implant-supported teeth are secured in position within the mouth, which may help reduce movement during speaking and eating.

Consultations for dental implants and All-On-4 dental implants generally involve a more detailed assessment of bone structure and oral health. Imaging may be required to determine whether implant placement is suitable and to help plan the positioning of the implants. Patients are also informed about healing periods, maintenance requirements, and the importance of long-term oral hygiene following treatment.

The dental team explained that recommendations are based on clinical findings and patient preferences rather than a single standard approach. Factors such as lifestyle, oral health condition, and the amount of support required from the replacement teeth are all considered during treatment planning. In some situations, removable dentures may remain the most practical option, while other patients may benefit from implant-supported solutions.

The practice noted that ongoing review appointments are an important part of denture care, as the shape of the gums and jaw can change gradually over time. Regular examinations allow adjustments to be made where necessary to maintain comfort and fit.
