



## **Christian Community Homes & Services Receives State and Local Recognition for Senior Living Communities**

The Willow Glen skilled nursing facility at the Hudson campus ranked number 12 among Wisconsin nursing homes in the 50 to 99 beds category in Newsweek's America's Best Nursing Homes 2026. Separately, the Osceola campus was named Best in the Valley for 2025 in a local reader survey.

The Newsweek ranking evaluated facilities based on resident feedback and other performance indicators. Christian Community Home - Hudson Campus achieved a score of 50 in the 50-99 beds category, placing it 12th in the state. The Osceola campus received the Best in the Valley designation through community voting in the St. Croix Valley region, reflecting local appreciation for its services.

These recognitions highlight the organization's ongoing commitment to delivering compassionate, faith-based care across its continuum of services. Both campuses operate as part of a nonprofit, faith-based

organization dedicated to nurturing graceful living for seniors.

The Hudson campus includes Willow Glen for skilled nursing and transitional care and rehabilitation, Pine Ridge for assisted living, Pine Ridge Gardens for secure memory care, and WinterGreen for independent senior apartments. The Osceola campus, situated adjacent to the Osceola Medical Center, offers skilled nursing, transitional care, rehabilitation, and assisted living. A covered link at the Osceola location allows residents convenient, protected access to medical services.

Shelly DeStasio, Director of Community Relations, addressed the significance of the honors. "These recognitions affirm the dedication of our entire team in providing individualized, compassionate care rooted in Christian values. We remain focused on serving each resident with dignity and respect."

The organization traces its origins to 1981, when the Hudson United Methodist Church and local supporters came together to preserve essential nursing home services in Hudson. What began as a single skilled nursing facility has grown into two comprehensive campuses that offer a full spectrum of senior living options. The mission emphasizes the importance of each unique life, integrating spiritual support such as worship services, Bible studies, and pastoral care alongside clinical and daily living assistance.

Services at both locations are tailored to individual needs through collaborative care planning involving residents, families, and healthcare professionals. Programs address physical health, emotional well-being, and social engagement while maintaining a faith-centered environment. The Christian Community Campus Foundation supports these efforts by directing donations toward resident assistance, equipment upgrades, staff development, and program enhancements.

The dual recognitions arrive as the senior population in the region continues to grow. Local demographic data indicate a rising percentage of residents aged 65 and older, increasing the importance of quality senior living communities. By earning both a statewide ranking and a local best designation, Christian Community Homes & Services demonstrates consistent performance across different evaluation methods.

The Newsweek ranking process considered factors including resident satisfaction surveys. The local Best in the Valley award stems from community input, underscoring the organization's standing among neighbors and families in the St. Croix Valley area.

Christian Community Homes & Services continues to invest in its facilities and staff to sustain high standards of care. Recent campus improvements at Hudson have included updates to dining areas and the conversion of select spaces to expand assisted living options, further enhancing the living environment for residents.
