"The financial aftermath of a serious accident can be just as overwhelming as the injuries themselves," said David Capra, personal injury lawyer at LMS Personal Injury Lawyers. "Our contingency model exists precisely so that the ability to pay never determines whether someone gets proper legal representation. If a claim exists, cost should not be the reason a victim walks away without pursuing it."

The firm handles a wide range of personal injury matters, including motor vehicle collisions, slip and fall accidents, dog bite claims, wrongful death, long-term disability claims, medical malpractice, product liability, restaurant and bar liability, property and fire loss claims, and CPP disability benefit claims. Contingency-based legal representation has long been recognized as a meaningful mechanism for expanding access to justice. When an injured person is unable to work and faces mounting rehabilitation costs, the no-fee-unless-we-win structure allows clients to pursue fair compensation for lost wages, medical expenses, pain and suffering, out-of-pocket costs, and long-term loss of earning capacity without assuming additional financial risk during recovery. The model aligns the firm's interests directly with those of the client ? the legal team is motivated to secure the strongest possible outcome because compensation is contingent on it.

"Many people who contact us have never worked with a lawyer before and are unsure whether they even have a case," said Russ Molot, personal injury lawyer at LMS Personal Injury Lawyers. "At a minimum, a person walks away understanding their options and their rights. In many cases, they walk away with a clear path to compensation they would not have recovered on their own."

The firm also emphasizes that timing matters. Ontario's Limitations Act imposes filing deadlines that, if missed, can permanently bar a claim regardless of its merit. Injured individuals are encouraged to consult an Ottawa personal injury lawyer as early as possible after an accident to preserve their legal options and ensure that evidence is collected before it becomes unavailable.
