Hitch alignment and secure connections are essential aspects of towing best practices. Ensuring the hitch is at the correct height and that all safety chains, breakaway cables, and electrical connections are properly attached contributes to overall safety on the highway. Many owners benefit from verifying these elements as part of routine pre-trip inspections.

Pre-trip inspections form a cornerstone of operational preparedness. These checks typically include examining tire pressure and tread wear on both the tow vehicle and the trailer, assessing brake functionality, and inspecting suspension components. Hitch-related items such as coupler condition and lubrication also warrant attention before departure.
