The findings highlighted strong aesthetic outcomes and high levels of patient satisfaction, supporting the role of porcelain veneers as a long-term cosmetic option when appropriately planned and maintained.

In addition to veneers, Crown Bank Dental Congleton has a number of cosmetic dental treatments available to improve the appearance of your smile. Teeth whitening remains a popular treatment for patients wishing to brighten discoloured teeth. Composite bonding can also be used to repair minor chips, reshape uneven edges or improve minor gaps with tooth coloured materials. The practice also provides cosmetic treatment planning to improve balance and symmetry whilst maintaining healthy tooth structure where possible.

In some situations, teeth whitening may be carried out before veneers are placed so that the surrounding teeth better match the planned shade. Composite bonding may also be considered for patients looking for smaller adjustments without the need for veneers across multiple

teeth.

Patients attending consultations are advised to maintain good oral hygiene and attend regular dental reviews after cosmetic treatment. Gum health and monitoring restorations over time are also important elements to maintaining the appearance and longevity of veneers and other cosmetic work, added Crown Bank Dental Congleton.

Patients come in for consultations with different priorities in appearance, durability and maintenance, the dental team said. Some people may want minor adjustments, while others may require more extensive cosmetic work for several teeth.
