



Cutarelli Vision Publishes EVO ICL Cost Breakdown for Denver, Colorado Patients

Cutarelli Vision, a LASIK surgeon located in Denver, Colorado, has published a detailed cost breakdown for EVO ICL surgery, covering pricing components, payment options, and tax-advantaged accounts available to patients across the Colorado Front Range. The Denver office serves patients seeking refractive surgery, including LASIK, PRK, EVO ICL, and Refractive Lens Exchange. EVO ICL pricing in the Denver area generally ranges from \$3,500 to \$5,500 per eye as of 2026, depending on prescription complexity and lens specifications, and is quoted per eye rather than as a bilateral total. EVO ICL pricing typically exceeds LASIK pricing because the procedure requires a custom-manufactured biocompatible lens implant and microsurgical placement inside the eye rather than surface laser reshaping of the cornea. A complete EVO ICL price quote at Cutarelli Vision covers the EVO ICL lens, surgeon's fee, facility charges, pre-operative diagnostic testing, and a standard schedule of post-operative follow-up visits. The practice provides patients with a written, itemized cost estimate during the free consultation at the Denver office, allowing review of every line item before scheduling. Cutarelli Vision serves EVO ICL, LASIK,

and PRK patients at four Colorado Front Range offices in Denver, Fort Collins, Boulder Valley, and Colorado Springs.

Most medical insurance plans do not cover EVO ICL surgery as of 2026, because carriers classify it as elective refractive surgery rather than a medically necessary procedure. EVO ICL is, however, an IRS-approved medical expense eligible for payment through Health Savings Account or Flexible Spending Account funds, and Cutarelli Vision provides itemized documentation for account reimbursement at the Denver office and at additional Colorado Front Range locations. The practice also offers 24-month and 36-month no-interest financing for refractive procedures, including EVO ICL, LASIK, PRK, and Refractive Lens Exchange. Patients in Fort Collins, Boulder Valley, and Colorado Springs evaluating EVO ICL have access to the same consultation and financing structure available at the Denver office.

"Patients deserve to see exactly what they are paying for before they schedule any refractive procedure," said Dr. Paul Cutarelli, MD, a Johns Hopkins-trained, board-certified corneal specialist and founder of Cutarelli Vision. "Our consultation process provides a written, itemized estimate that breaks down the lens cost, surgeon's fee, facility charges, and pre-operative testing, so patients can evaluate the full picture of the procedure before making any decision." Dr. Cutarelli completed his ophthalmology residency at the Wilmer Eye Institute at Johns Hopkins Hospital and a fellowship in anterior segment surgery and ocular disease at Moorfields Eye Hospital in London. He has performed over 90,000 vision correction procedures since entering practice in 1995. Cutarelli Vision is surgeon-owned and operated, with Dr. Cutarelli personally performing refractive procedures including EVO ICL, LASIK, PRK, and Refractive Lens Exchange at the practice's Denver office and additional Colorado Front Range locations.

Cutarelli Vision's Denver office is located at 7900 E Union Ave #100, Denver, Colorado 80237, and serves patients throughout Denver, Fort Collins, Boulder Valley, and Colorado Springs. The Denver Tech Center location offers free EVO ICL consultations during weekday business hours and accepts HSA, FSA, and approved no-interest financing as forms of payment for refractive surgery. The Denver office also serves as a referral destination for patients from outside Colorado, with the practice's surgeon-owned model and corneal subspecialty focus drawing patients from beyond the Front Range for LASIK, PRK, EVO ICL, and Refractive Lens Exchange evaluations.
