



Crusaders Fence Launches Wood Fence Installation Services

Crusaders Fence, a licensed fencing contractor based in the Fredericksburg area, is now taking on residential wood fence installations across Central Virginia, with board-on-board, board-on-batten, and ranch configurations available for suburban and rural properties.

Wood is the most requested fencing material in the Fredericksburg metro area. The reasons are practical: it costs less per linear foot than vinyl or aluminum, takes stain and paint to match existing structures, and looks right in neighborhoods from older developments to new subdivisions. Performance depends almost entirely on installation, not the material itself. Central Virginia's red clay soil absorbs moisture and moves through each winter's temperature swings, and posts that are not anchored deep enough tilt out of alignment within a few seasons. Crusaders Fence sets every post in high-PSI concrete, a fast-curing, high-strength mix, at a depth below the frost line, typically between 24 and 36 inches depending on the property, and uses exterior-grade fasteners and reinforced brackets on every job.

The company installs board-on-board and board-on-batten configurations in four-, five-, and six-foot heights. Pressure-treated pine is the standard material ? it handles ground contact and moisture exposure without chemical treatment. Cedar is available for homeowners who prefer a species that naturally resists rot and insects. Crusaders Fence also handles three-board and four-board ranch configurations with wire mesh for rural properties and paddock enclosures. When neighboring homeowners coordinate a shared fence line at the same time, the company offers a Good Neighbor discount that reduces material handling and labor costs for both properties.

Permit requirements vary across the region. Most residential fence projects in Stafford County, Spotsylvania County, and the City of Fredericksburg require a building permit, and properties within homeowners associations need a separate approval process before installation begins. Crusaders Fence prepares and submits permit documentation, coordinates HOA approval requests, and schedules Virginia 811 utility marking, the state-required process that identifies buried gas, water, and electrical lines before any digging starts, on behalf of each homeowner.

Each project begins with an on-site consultation. Finn walks the property with the homeowner, reviews the fence line, notes any grade changes or obstacles that will affect installation, and issues a written estimate before leaving. Most installations take one to two days. After the work is finished, Finn walks the completed fence with the homeowner and schedules a follow-up visit once it has had time to settle.

"Wood fencing is still what most homeowners around here ask about first, and it makes sense. It fits the look of the neighborhoods, and it holds up when it's put in right. The difference between a fence that lasts and one that starts leaning in three winters comes down to what you do before the first board goes up ? how deep you dig, the concrete you use, and whether you've checked for what's underground before you start. Those aren't visible when the job is done. But they're what makes the fence stay where you put it," said Conall Finn, owner of Crusaders Fence.
