The scope of a personal injury firm's practice categories is a material consideration for accident victims evaluating legal representation. Injuries sustained in a single accident can give rise to claims across multiple legal frameworks simultaneously. A motor vehicle collision involving a commercial truck, for example, may produce claims under traffic law, commercial carrier regulations, and insurance legislation, while also involving long-term disability entitlements if the victim's injuries prevent a return to employment. A firm with defined competency across multiple categories is better positioned to manage that complexity than one whose practice is limited to a narrower set of circumstances.

Truck accident claims represent one of the more technically complex categories within personal injury law, as commercial carriers are subject to federal and provincial regulations governing vehicle maintenance, driver hours of service, load securing, and operator licensing. Establishing liability in truck accident cases often requires an investigation into regulatory compliance records alongside the standard reconstruction of accident circumstances. Medical malpractice claims present a different set of demands, requiring expert medical evidence to establish the standard of care applicable to a given procedure and demonstrate how the care received deviated from that standard.

“Every personal injury category on that list represents a set of circumstances where someone has been seriously hurt and needs legal support to navigate the process,” said David Capra, Principal of LMS Personal Injury Lawyers. “The breadth of our practice exists because the accidents that produce serious injuries don’t fit neatly into a single legal box. Our clients benefit from having a firm that understands the full picture from the beginning.”

LMS Personal Injury Lawyers operates on a contingency fee basis, meaning clients are not required to pay legal fees unless a successful outcome is achieved. That fee structure removes the financial barrier that might otherwise prevent accident victims from accessing a qualified personal injury lawyer in Ottawa representation following a serious injury, particularly during periods when the victim is unable to work and facing mounting medical and rehabilitation costs. The firm’s no-fee-unless-we-win policy applies across all eleven practice categories.

The firm provides car accident lawyers in Ottawa as part of its motor vehicle practice, representing clients in claims arising from collisions involving passenger vehicles, motorcycles, commercial trucks, and other road users. Ontario’s motor vehicle insurance framework involves statutory accident benefits, tort liability claims, and, in some cases, arbitration or litigation proceedings, depending on the nature of the injuries sustained and the positions taken by the insurers involved. Personal injury claims in Ontario are subject to limitation periods that restrict the time within which a legal action can be commenced. For most claims, the standard two-year limitation period begins from the date the injury was discovered or ought reasonably to have been discovered. Certain categories, including claims involving minors and some medical malpractice cases, are subject to different limitation rules. Accident victims who delay seeking legal advice risk losing the ability to pursue compensation regardless of the strength of their underlying claim.
