



Modern Vision Solutions Offers LipiFlow Dry Eye Treatment at Omaha, Nebraska Optometry Practice

Modern Vision Solutions, an optometry practice located in Omaha, Nebraska, offers LipiFlow thermal pulsation therapy at its Omaha office as part of a multi-treatment dry eye program. LipiFlow is provided alongside BlephEx, OptiLIGHT IPL, and punctal plugs, allowing patients with meibomian gland dysfunction to access multiple in-office dry eye treatments at one practice. The practice has published a new educational resource, "What is Lipiflow for Dry Eye in Omaha?", explaining how the FDA-cleared device addresses the most common cause of evaporative dry eye.

Meibomian gland dysfunction, or MGD, accounts for the majority of evaporative dry eye cases. This category of dry eye is driven by tear film instability rather than insufficient tear production. LipiFlow targets MGD by applying controlled heat at 42.5 degrees Celsius (108.5 degrees Fahrenheit) to the inner eyelid surface while delivering pulsating pressure to the outer eyelid, clearing blocked meibomian glands during a 12-minute in-office session. According to clinical information referenced in the practice's 2026 patient education materials, symptom improvement typically becomes noticeable within two to four weeks of treatment, with optimal results around six to eight weeks and relief lasting nine to twelve months. Some patients experience benefits for up to two years depending on MGD severity and environmental factors. The materials also note

that LipiFlow delivers sustained, regulated heat directly to the inner eyelid surface at a therapeutic temperature warm compresses cannot consistently reach, since compresses lose heat rapidly and apply pressure only from the outside. Clinical studies referenced by the practice indicate LipiFlow produces greater meibomian gland secretion improvement than warm compresses alone, particularly for moderate to severe MGD.

At its Omaha office, Modern Vision Solutions performs a diagnostic evaluation that maps meibomian gland structure and tear film quality before recommending LipiFlow, BlephEx, OptiLIGHT IPL, punctal plugs, or a combination. The treatments address different layers of dry eye disease: BlephEx clears bacterial biofilm and debris from the eyelid margins, LipiFlow addresses blockages deeper within the meibomian glands, and OptiLIGHT IPL reduces eyelid inflammation that contributes to gland dysfunction. The combination and sequencing depend on diagnostic findings from the in-office evaluation. The dry eye program operates alongside the practice's myopia control, comprehensive eye exam, and contact lens fitting services, serving residents of Omaha, West Omaha, Papillion, La Vista, Bellevue, and Council Bluffs. Patients across these communities who have tried warm compresses or over-the-counter drops without sustained relief can be evaluated for in-office MGD treatment at the Omaha location.

"Dry eye is frequently under-diagnosed, and many patients in Omaha have spent years cycling through drops and warm compresses that never reach the underlying gland blockage," said Dr. Meagan Anderson, OD, lead optometrist at Modern Vision Solutions in Omaha. "LipiFlow targets the meibomian glands directly. Pairing the treatment with diagnostic imaging means we can match each patient to the therapy their specific gland function calls for, rather than treating every dry eye case the same way." Dr. Anderson holds a Doctor of Optometry from the University of Missouri ? St. Louis College of Optometry and completed her residency in Refractive Surgery and Primary Care at Kugler Vision in Omaha. She is a member of the American Optometric Association, the American Academy of Optometry, and the Nebraska Optometric Association.

Modern Vision Solutions is located at 10345 Pacific St, Omaha, NE 68114, with on-site patient parking and access from major Omaha thoroughfares. The Omaha office serves patients across Omaha, West Omaha, Papillion, La Vista, Bellevue, and nearby Council Bluffs, Iowa. The Omaha office opened in October 2022 and operates under a published No-Pressure Promise, meaning patients seeking a dry eye evaluation, eyeglasses, or contact lens fitting will not be pushed to purchase eyewear at the practice.
