With proper care, these restorations can provide many years of reliable function.

"Precise fit is critical, as a properly designed crown supports healthy gums, maintains bite alignment, and allows comfortable chewing while blending seamlessly with the patient's smile."

Dr. Duewer completed his Bachelor of Science degree at Southern Illinois University Edwardsville and earned his Doctor of Dental Medicine degree from the Southern Illinois University School of Dental Medicine in 2017.
