Wake County continues its rapid expansion, adding approximately 66 new residents daily and accumulating more than 103,000 new residents since 2020, according to Wake County Government data. This unprecedented growth has created significant pressure on the local housing market, with the county projected to need between 125,000 and 175,000 new housing units over the next decade. As housing availability tightens and prices rise, many Triangle area homeowners are choosing renovation over relocation, driving increased demand for kitchen and bath remodeling services throughout the region.

USA Cabinet Store LLC, which operates a showroom in Cary, has positioned itself to meet this growing renovation demand by offering comprehensive kitchen remodeling and bathroom remodeling services to homeowners across the Research Triangle. "The population growth in Wake County has fundamentally changed how homeowners approach their living

spaces," said Emin Halac, CEO of USA Cabinet Store LLC. "Rather than competing in an increasingly competitive real estate market, many residents are investing in transforming their current homes to meet their evolving needs."

The surge in renovation activity aligns with broader regional trends. The City of Raleigh issued 1,416 residential building permits out of 8,113 total permits in Wake County in 2025, demonstrating the scale of construction and renovation activity throughout the area. Seven of North Carolina's 15 fastest-growing places are located in Wake County, according to the Triangle Business Journal, with the state overall growing 1.3 percent to reach 11.2 million residents.

National data from the Harvard Joint Center for Housing Studies indicates that remodeling spending continues to rise at approximately 2.9 percent in early 2026, reflecting sustained homeowner investment in property improvements. The 2026 NKBA Kitchen Trends Report highlights emerging design priorities including smart technology integration, health and wellness features, and personalized luxury elements that are shaping kitchen and bath remodeling projects.

The Cary showroom displays nine cabinet lines ranging from ready-to-assemble options to German-engineered frameless construction, serving homeowners throughout Wake, Durham, Orange, and Chatham counties. The facility operates as part of a network of 14 showrooms across seven states, providing access to national purchasing power while maintaining local service delivery.
