A 2019 study titled "A Comparison of Treatment Effectiveness Between Clear Aligner and Fixed Appliance Therapies", published in BMC Oral Health and conducted in Beijing, China, found that both clear aligners and traditional braces can effectively straighten teeth and correct bite problems. Researchers Ke Y, Zhu Y, and Zhu M noted that clear aligners may offer advantages, including more targeted tooth movement and, in some cases, shorter treatment times. The study concluded that dentists and orthodontists should consider the differences between these two approaches and select the most suitable treatment according to each patient's individual needs.

Consultations are intended to help patients understand whether Invisalign clear aligners may be appropriate for their circumstances. Initial assessments generally include an examination of the teeth and gums, a discussion of treatment objectives, and a review of oral health considerations that may influence treatment planning. Digital scans or impressions may also be taken to assist with developing a personalised treatment plan.
