The resource also discusses the role of terrain and accessibility. Steep slopes, uneven ground, rocky conditions, and limited equipment access can increase the time required to complete a project. The guide notes that these site conditions are often considered during the estimating process because they affect both efficiency and equipment operation.

Another topic covered in the publication is property size. Larger tracts of land may have different per-acre pricing than smaller parcels because equipment can operate more efficiently across a larger work area. The article explains that minimum project charges can also affect pricing for smaller jobs, making total acreage an important factor in cost estimates.

The guide also distinguishes bush hogging from other land management services. While bush hogging is commonly used to manage grass, weeds, and light brush, some properties may require more extensive clearing methods depending on vegetation conditions and project goals.
