A 2018 study published in JAMA Network Open found that chiropractic care added to usual medical care resulted in moderate short-term improvements in low back pain intensity and functional outcomes compared to usual medical care alone. Additional research, including a 2024 review, has shown positive associations

with spinal manipulation for chronic back pain relief.

Dr. John Carleton and Dr. Mary Carleton, both graduates of Logan College of Chiropractic with more than two decades of experience each, lead the care at the practice. Dr. John Carleton brings expertise in Chiropractic Biophysics and Active Release Technique, informed by his prior work as an emergency medical technician and in physical therapy. Dr. Mary Carleton holds certification through the International Chiropractic Pediatric Association and emphasizes approaches suitable for families.

The practice utilizes techniques including spinal decompression, flexion-distraction, intersegmental traction therapy, electrotherapy, Arthrostim instrument adjusting, and low-force adjustments. These methods are applied following patient assessments to address spinal alignment and support mobility. Care extends to related services such as prenatal care, sports and athlete support, auto injury recovery, wellness programs, and pediatric care.

Dr. Mary Carleton shared insights on the role of education. "Patient education helps families understand spinal health and wellness considerations," said Dr. Mary Carleton. "Collaborative approaches support individuals in exploring proactive strategies."

Dr. John Carleton addressed the collaborative nature of the practice. "Working together enables the practice to address family needs across different life stages," said Dr. John Carleton.

A longitudinal observational study of adults with low back and neck pain receiving chiropractic care reported statistically significant improvements in physical and mental health-related quality of life measures after three months. Other recent research has documented positive outcomes associated with chiropractic spinal manipulation for back pain management.

Patient education is integrated into the services at Wave Chiropractic. The practice offers interactive spine education resources that cover the cervical, thoracic, lumbar, sacral, and coccyx regions. These tools provide details on nerve root connections and their relationships to body functions.

The clinic maintains a collection of chiropractic videos on adjustment techniques, spinal health principles, stress management, and related topics. These materials, along with frequently asked questions and blog content, support patient learning about chiropractic concepts.
