## **Learning Tree Academy Offers Summer Camp to Support School Readiness at Succasunna Location**

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Learning Tree Academy offers its summer camp program at the Succasunna location to help children maintain learning momentum during the summer months. The program runs from June 22 through August 27 and serves children in preschool through first grade.

The summer camp combines structured activities with creative play to support continued development. Daily programming includes themed projects that incorporate art, science, and math elements. Children participate in arts and crafts, group games, music, stories, and movement activities. Past special events have included fun themes like Crazy Hat Day, Hawaiian Day, inflatable bouncy castle sessions, Mad Science Workshops, magic shows, pajama parties, and Sports Day, which add variety to the schedule. Water play and outdoor exploration are included when weather conditions allow.

The program operates daily from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. with before and after care available. This schedule accommodates working families while providing consistency for children. The camp takes place in the academy's familiar environment with the same experienced teachers children know from the regular school year. This continuity helps reinforce social skills, routines, and age-appropriate learning.

Summer camp experiences contribute to school readiness by maintaining educational engagement during the break. Children practice skills in a play-based setting that supports knowledge retention and eases the transition back to school in the fall. The structured yet enjoyable format balances active play, creative expression, rest, and learning opportunities.

Nataliya Malinovsky, Owner, said, "Our summer camp program helps children in preschool through first grade stay connected to learning through engaging activities and familiar routines."

The academy uses The Creative Curriculum as the foundation for its programs. This research-based approach treats every part of the day as a learning opportunity and supports the development of the whole child across social-emotional, physical, cognitive, and language domains. Teachers adapt activities to children's interests while maintaining small group sizes for individualized attention.

Safety remains a top priority at the Succasunna facility. The center features 24/7 video surveillance, a secure entry system, and commercial-grade UV air purification systems. The Positive Discipline approach guides children in developing respect, problem-solving abilities, cooperation, and personal responsibility.

The Succasunna location serves families from Succasunna, Roxbury Township, Kenvil, Rockaway, Mine Hill, Mt. Arlington, Randolph, Ledgewood, Denville, Netcong, Mt. Olive Township, Flanders, Wharton, Parsippany, and Dover. Before and after-school care is offered for students attending Roxbury Township elementary schools with district-provided bus transportation. The academy partners with the Wharton School District for the universal preschool program.

Nataliya Malinovsky, Owner, stated, "By participating in summer camp, children benefit from consistent experiences that build confidence and prepare them for the upcoming school year in a supportive environment."

Enrollment for summer camp typically opens in February. Families provide meals and snacks in accordance with nutrition and allergy guidelines. A 10 percent sibling discount is available. Teachers participate in ongoing professional development to align with best practices in early childhood education.

The academy maintains strong communication with families throughout the program. Regular updates help ensure continuity between home and the center. This collaboration supports each child's individual growth and development.

Learning Tree Academy provides early childhood care and education in Morris County. The academy offers programs for children from six weeks old through preschool, along with summer camp and school-age care

options. Programs emphasize play-based learning and whole-child development in a supportive setting.
