"Addressing these issues early typically involves minor adjustments or component replacements, whereas waiting often results in complete system failure at the most inconvenient times."

The company notes that garage door systems experience increased stress during summer months due to frequent use and thermal expansion of metal components. Heat can affect lubricants, cause electronic components to malfunction, and accelerate wear on moving parts. Springs, which bear significant weight and tension, become particularly vulnerable to failure when already showing signs of fatigue.

Misaligned sensors represent another frequently overlooked issue that can escalate quickly. These safety devices prevent the door from closing on objects or people, but when improperly aligned, they can cause erratic behavior or prevent the door from functioning entirely. Similarly, weather seal deterioration may seem minor but can lead to increased energy costs and allow pests or moisture to enter the garage space.

The importance of regular maintenance becomes evident when considering that most garage doors operate multiple times daily, accumulating thousands of cycles annually. Each component works in concert with others, meaning that one failing part can place additional stress on the entire system, accelerating overall deterioration.

"Summer preparation should include a thorough inspection of all garage door components," added Kelsch. "Property owners who schedule preventive maintenance typically avoid the frustration and expense of emergency repairs during peak season when service demand is highest."
