Spring condition represents another critical safety consideration. Garage door springs bear significant tension and support the door's weight during operation. Visual inspection can reveal signs of wear, including gaps in the coils, rust, or stretched appearance. Springs nearing the end of their service life may cause doors to operate unevenly or produce grinding sounds during movement.

Track alignment affects both safety and performance. Misaligned tracks can cause doors to bind, stick, or operate roughly. Homeowners should observe the door's movement from inside the garage, watching for any wobbling or uneven motion. Rollers should move smoothly within the tracks without excessive friction or noise.

Unusual sounds during operation often indicate developing problems. Squeaking, grinding, popping, or banging noises suggest components need attention. While some sounds result from normal wear requiring lubrication, others may signal more serious issues requiring professional evaluation.

Regular maintenance extends beyond safety considerations to include system longevity and reliability. Annual professional inspections typically include lubrication of moving parts, hardware tightening, balance testing, and comprehensive safety feature verification.
