Insta Graphic Systems has completed delivery of heat transfer names and numbers for FIFA World Cup Federation jerseys being used in the 2026 FIFA World Cup tournament currently underway in Los Angeles. The California-based manufacturer also deployed its heat press machinery to Federation facilities, enabling on-site jersey customization throughout the tournament.

The company's heat transfer technology is now visible on jerseys worn by players from participating nations during match play.

One example of this work is Insta Graphic Systems' partnership with Capelli Sport in support of the Cabo Verde Football Federation.

Insta Graphic Systems' work also gained visibility during the FIFA World Cup countdown concert on June 10, 2026, when Walshy Fire of Major Lazer performed in a jersey that was printed using Insta Graphic Systems' custom heat transfers and heat press machinery before an audience of more than 100,000 spectators. Insta worked together with creative director, Ouigie Theodore, of The Brooklyn Circus as well as Sunni Flemming and Judith LaBranche to make the jersey placement happen. The appearance highlighted the company's heat transfer applications on a global stage ahead of tournament competition.

The project utilized Insta Graphic Systems' automatic heat press machines, available at <https://www.instagram.com/heat-press-machines/automatic-heat-presses/>, which provide temperature and pressure control for jersey customization. These machines enable consistent application across multiple jerseys, meeting the production demands of international competition.

The World Cup project represents a significant application of Insta Graphic Systems' manufacturing capabilities, which span over 65 years of production. The company's involvement includes both the initial production of Federation jersey transfers and ongoing technical support for the machinery deployed at tournament venues.
