



American Cornhole Announces Owensboro as Host City for ACO World Championships 21

The American Cornhole Organization (ACO) has selected Owensboro, Kentucky, as the host city for the ACO World Championships of Cornhole Season 21, scheduled to take place July 20-25, 2026, at the Owensboro Convention Center. This marks the third time the organization has chosen Owensboro to host its premier annual tournament event.

The six-day championship event represents the culmination of the ACO's competitive season, bringing together top-ranked cornhole players from across the nation and internationally to compete for world titles across multiple divisions.
