With over 29,000 pool renovations completed across the San Francisco Bay Area, Central Valley, and Monterey Peninsula, the Pleasanton-based company has identified key indicators that signal when pool surfaces need professional attention. These signs include visible etching, staining that cannot be removed through chemical treatment, rough textures that can cause injuries, and delamination where the surface material separates from the underlying structure.

"Pool surface deterioration typically becomes noticeable after seven to ten years for standard plaster finishes, though environmental factors and maintenance practices significantly impact longevity," said Ray Langford, Marketing Director at Adams Pool Solutions. "Understanding the differences between surface materials helps homeowners make informed decisions that align with their budget and long-term pool maintenance goals."

The company distinguishes between three primary surface finish options available to Bay Area homeowners. Traditional white plaster remains the most economical choice, offering a smooth finish that typically lasts seven to ten years with proper maintenance. Quartz finishes incorporate colored quartz crystals into the plaster mixture, providing enhanced durability and aesthetic appeal with an expected lifespan of ten to fifteen years. Pebble finishes, which embed small river pebbles into the surface material, deliver the longest service life at fifteen to twenty years while offering superior resistance to chemicals and staining.

Adams Pool Solutions pool resurfacing in the Bay Area encompasses both residential and commercial properties, with the company completing approximately 1,200 projects annually. The decision between

resurfacing and replastering depends on several factors including the extent of surface damage, structural integrity of the existing shell, and homeowner preferences for finish type and color.

Replastering involves removing the existing surface completely and applying new material, typically necessary when surfaces show extensive cracking, hollowing, or structural compromise. Resurfacing, conversely, addresses cosmetic issues and minor surface degradation without complete removal, making it a more cost-effective option for pools with fundamentally sound surfaces.
