Compact track loaders and telehandlers have emerged as practical solutions to these on-site demands.

Track loaders are commonly deployed for earthmoving, site clearing, levelling, and material handling tasks on tight residential sites. Telehandlers offer flexible lifting and loading capability that translates well across varied terrain and a broad range of applications. Both machine categories are built to hold up in the physically demanding and variable conditions that tradies and landscapers encounter throughout the working day.

"We have been seeing more inquiries from tradies and landscapers who are specifically looking at compact options," said a spokesperson for STM Trucks & Machinery. "The ASV track loaders and Merlo telehandlers we carry are designed for confined access work and are regularly used on residential sites and landscaping jobs where larger equipment cannot operate."

The company has been supplying trucks and machinery trucks and machinery supplier to operators across New South Wales for over five decades. It has accumulated experience across a broad range of truck and machinery applications over that time, serving operators from independent tradies through to established construction businesses. The company provides 24-hour emergency support for operators facing unexpected breakdowns in the field and maintains a parts inventory covering genuine and aftermarket options for its machinery brands. Parts orders are handled through STM's dedicated parts team, with delivery running twice daily across Metropolitan Sydney and extending to the Southern Highlands and Wollongong each afternoon.
