The Beach Street Inn Publishes GPS-Guided Driving Tour App

August 15, 2026

St. Martins, New Brunswick - August 15, 2026 -

The Beach Street Inn has produced and published a self-drive audio tour of the Bay of Fundy coast under the name Experience the Bay of Fundy, with the descriptive strapline Bay of Fundy Driving Tour. The GPS-guided app is available on Apple App Store and Google Play, free to download with an optional in-app premium tier, and authored by the inn from its base in St. Martins, New Brunswick.

The Beach Street Inn provides curated Bay of Fundy experiences for visitors across St. Martins, New Brunswick, anchored on its boutique inn accommodation and a tour programme themed around the surrounding region. Coverage in the driving-tour app extends across the UNESCO Fundy Biosphere Region and Stonehammer UNESCO Global Geopark, the two UNESCO designations that encompass the geography around the inn. Produced under a grant and launched in 2024, the app carries developer attribution to Beach Street Inn and a corporate seller listing under Beach Street Inn Inc.

The audio content covers lighthouses along the Bay of Fundy coast, the St. Martins Sea Caves, the village's

working harbour, and the heritage and culture of the surrounding area. Themes carried through the tour include the village's shipbuilding history, prohibition-era rum-running lore, ghost stories tied to the coast, the regional geology, and the UNESCO context that frames the wider Bay of Fundy as a place of international scientific interest. The tour structure is a self-drive route that triggers content based on the listener's GPS position.

Experience the Bay of Fundy is distributed on both the Apple App Store and Google Play. The Apple listing supports iPhone, iPad, iPod touch, Mac with Apple silicon, and Apple Vision, with the Android version available through Google Play. Download is free across both platforms. An optional in-app premium tier under the name Gateway to the Bay of Fundy, priced at CAD \$19.99, gives access to additional content beyond the free base layer.

"Guests arriving from the Northeast United States, Quebec, and Ontario often want more than a list of things to see when they come to the Bay of Fundy," said Beth Winkle, owner of The Beach Street Inn. "What we built into Experience the Bay of Fundy is the kind of route I would want to be told about by a local: the lighthouses worth looking at first, the harbour stories, the sea caves at the right tide, the shipbuilding history we have grown up around, the ghost lore that used to be told evening by evening. A self-drive audio tour that runs on a phone seemed like the right form for the way our guests actually travel through this coast."

The Beach Street Inn sits in a heritage building on Beach Street that dates from 1890, the era of the village's shipbuilding industry. Family ties to the area go back to 1942, when Beth Winkle's grandfather Harry purchased five cottages overlooking the harbour, and the current trading identity has been in operation since 2021. Authoring and publishing a route-based audio tour of the surrounding coast extends the inn's role beyond accommodation alone, with the same coastline running through both the inn's view and the route the tour traces.

The Bay of Fundy is the body of water bordering southern New Brunswick and Nova Scotia, recognized internationally for the highest tides on record. Around St. Martins, attractions include Fundy Trail Provincial Park, the St. Martins Sea Caves, a series of covered bridges, and a route through to Saint John, New Brunswick. Two UNESCO designations, the Fundy Biosphere Region and Stonehammer UNESCO Global Geopark, sit across overlapping geography that the driving tour traces in part as a route, with the inn positioned as the base point.

Experience the Bay of Fundy is available from Apple App Store and from Google Play. Further information about the inn and the wider experience programme it operates is available at The Beach Street Inn website, with seasonal updates posted to the inn's Facebook page throughout the open season.
