



Park Place Construction Spotlights Roofing Ahead of Storm Season

HUNTINGTOWN, MD - June 25, 2026 -

Park Place Construction, a family-owned general contractor and CertainTeed Shingle Master company based in Huntingtown, is drawing attention to its residential roofing services as the 2026 Atlantic hurricane season moves toward its late-summer peak. The company is encouraging homeowners across Calvert, Anne Arundel, Charles, and Saint Mary's counties to address roof wear before the period when wind and storm activity tends to be heaviest.

Roofing sits at the center of the message because the work is governed by manufacturer standards that affect how a roof performs under stress. As a CertainTeed Shingle Master company, Park Place Construction installs and repairs asphalt shingle roofing to the specifications tied to that designation, which cover underlayment, fastening, and flashing details rather than the shingles alone. The designation is held by roofing companies that complete the manufacturer's training, and it can affect the warranty coverage a homeowner is eligible to receive.

"As a CertainTeed Shingle Master company, our crews follow the manufacturer's installation standards on every roof, and that consistency matters most when a home is facing a storm season," said Albert DeCesaris, owner and lead builder of Park Place Construction. "Our focus is on getting the parts a homeowner never sees correct, because those are the parts that keep water out."

In Southern Maryland's climate, the most common roof problems involve the transitions on a roof rather than the broad field of shingles. Wind can lift or crease shingles and break their seal, flashing around chimneys and valleys can loosen over time, and summer heat and humidity gradually wear the protective granule layer. Park Place Construction assesses these points during a roof evaluation and recommends repair or replacement based on the condition it finds.

The company operates as a licensed general contractor under Maryland Home Improvement Commission license number 21761 and manages each project from an initial property assessment through permitting and a final walkthrough. Permits and inspections are handled in house, and homeowners work with the same Huntingtown-based crew throughout a project. The company describes its estimating approach as no-pressure, providing a written assessment before any work is scheduled.

Beyond roofing, Park Place Construction provides siding, window, door, and gutter installation, custom deck building in composite and wood, and outdoor living structures that include pergolas, pavilions, gazebos, carports, sheds, and a range of covered, screened, and enclosed porches. As a general contractor, the company also completes home additions, master suite additions, garage builds, and finished basements, coordinating design, permitting, and construction for larger structural projects.

DeCesaris said the seasonal timing is the reason the company is raising the subject now. "Most roof problems start small, at a lifted shingle or a worn piece of flashing, and a storm season is what turns a small problem into an interior leak," he said. "Our recommendation to homeowners is to have any wear looked at before the heaviest weather arrives, not after."

From its Huntingtown location in Calvert County, Park Place Construction serves a service area that extends north into Anne Arundel County, west into Charles County, and south into Saint Mary's County. The company coordinates all projects from that single base rather than operating separate branch offices.

Park Place Construction is a family-owned business based in Huntingtown that has served the Southern Maryland region for decades. The company is licensed, bonded, and insured under Maryland Home Improvement Commission license number 21761, is accredited by the Better Business Bureau, and holds CertainTeed Shingle Master company status. Its office is staffed Monday through Friday for estimates,

scheduling, and project questions, and free project estimates are available throughout its service area.
