



A Family Chiropractic Clinic Announces Relocation to New Denton Address to Support Continued Clinical Operations

Denton, TX - June 25, 2026 -

A Family Chiropractic Clinic has relocated to 3327 Colorado Blvd, Suite 400, Denton, TX 76210, marking the latest chapter in a practice that has operated continuously in the Denton area for more than four decades. The move to a smaller, purpose-fitted space on Colorado Boulevard reflects a deliberate direction for the clinic ? one that prioritizes depth of care over volume of patients.

The independent chiropractic practice is led by Dr. Robert T. Howell, DVM, DC, FACO, a chiropractic orthopedic specialist who has been in active practice since graduating from Life Chiropractic University in 1981. In the years since, Dr. Howell has built a practice defined less by its size than by its clinical approach ? extended appointments, thorough assessment, and a focus on identifying the underlying causes of a patient's condition rather than addressing symptoms in isolation.

His decades in practice have shaped a clinical philosophy that runs counter to the direction many healthcare

practices have taken. Where many clinics have grown in size and moved toward higher patient throughput, A Family Chiropractic Clinic has remained intentionally small. The new Colorado Boulevard location ? compact, quiet, and designed around one-on-one interaction ? reflects that orientation directly.

Independent chiropractic practices of this kind occupy a distinct space in the healthcare landscape. Unlike larger multi-provider clinics or franchise-model operations, they are built around continuity with a single physician, extended appointment time, and an approach to assessment that looks for underlying causes rather than treating presenting symptoms in isolation. Patients in this model typically see the same provider at every visit and develop a longitudinal relationship that informs how their care evolves over time. That consistency, difficult to replicate at scale, is increasingly what distinguishes smaller independent practices.

The new facility has drawn positive responses from patients since the clinic's arrival. Recurring feedback has centered on the character of the space itself ? its comfort, its quieter atmosphere, and the sense that appointments unfold without time pressure. New patients, in particular, have noted the thoroughness of the intake and assessment process. For a practice that has built its reputation on exactly that quality, the new setting appears to be a natural fit.

The clinic offers chiropractic care alongside a range of adjunct therapies, including Frequency Specific Microcurrent ? a modality that remains relatively rare in clinical practice in the region. FSM uses low-level electrical frequencies to target pain, inflammation, and soft tissue conditions at a cellular level. It is used in the treatment of a range of complex conditions, including peripheral neuropathy, fibromyalgia, and musculoskeletal pain that has not responded well to other interventions. Its availability at an independent chiropractic clinic in Denton is uncommon, and it has become a meaningful part of what draws patients who have not found adequate relief elsewhere.

The broader shift toward independent and boutique healthcare models reflects a recognizable pattern across medicine. Patients seeking more individualized attention, longer appointments, and a provider relationship that extends beyond a single episode of care have increasingly sought out practices that are structured to offer exactly that. For those practices, physical space matters ? not for reasons of prestige or branding, but because the environment either supports or undermines the clinical experience. A waiting room that feels institutional, or a treatment area without privacy or calm, works against the kind of interaction these practices are built around.

The Colorado Boulevard location was selected with those considerations in mind. It is smaller than the clinic's previous address, and deliberately so. The reduction in scale brings the space into alignment with how the practice actually operates ? a physician-led clinic functioning at a pace that allows for genuine clinical attention at each visit.

Dr. Howell noted that the relocation was not simply a change of address. "The objective was to find an environment that reflects how we actually practice," he said. "That means a setting where patients aren't moving through a system ? they're being seen and evaluated as individuals. The new space supports that."
