

LVMC Decks Renews Dual TimberTech and Trex Platinum Certifications

NAZARETH, PA - June 25, 2026 -

LVMC Decks, a family-owned and family-operated deck and outdoor living builder serving eastern Pennsylvania, has renewed its contractor certifications at the Platinum tier with both TimberTech and Trex for the current year. Contractors holding Platinum-tier credentials from both composite manufacturers at the same time remain relatively uncommon across the region, and the dual standing qualifies the company to install the full product lines from each manufacturer under their respective material warranties.

Both credentials are reissued annually based on installation volume, completed training, and inspected workmanship, rather than granted once and held indefinitely. The renewal coincides with the company reporting more than 3,000 completed projects over its 13 years in business, supported by a team that carries roughly 60 years of combined trade experience. The company is also a member of the North American Deck and Railing Association, an industry group focused on construction standards and safety training. Norman Boell serves as vice president of the company.

"Holding the Platinum tier with both manufacturers means our crews are trained and inspected to each company's current standards, not approved once and left alone," said Norman Boell, vice president of LVMC Decks. "That ongoing training is what stands behind the long material warranties."

The distinction carries practical weight in the company's primary market. The Pocono Mountains and the surrounding Lehigh Valley place heavy demands on outdoor structures, with substantial winter snow loads, repeated freeze and thaw cycles, sustained summer humidity, and wide temperature swings between elevations. Those conditions make material selection and structural detailing more consequential than in flatter, drier regions, and the manufacturer training behind each certification centers on correct installation for long-term performance.

Material warranty coverage reflects that emphasis. Trex residential material warranties extend up to 25 years,

and TimberTech reaches up to 50 years on qualifying product lines when the products are installed to specification. LVMC Decks adds a lifetime craftsmanship warranty covering its own framing and installation, separate from those manufacturer warranties.

"Decks are what the company was built on, and making them last in this climate comes down to the framing and the footings as much as the boards on top," Boell said. "Everything added around a deck is designed to work with that structure."

Decks remain the core of the company's work. LVMC Decks builds residential and commercial decks in configurations that include platform, raised, multi-level, freestanding, rooftop, poolside, and cantilevered designs, working primarily in composite and PVC alongside pressure-treated and hardwood options. Each project follows a defined sequence that begins with a design consultation supported by three-dimensional deck models and two-dimensional floorplans, then moves through foundation work, framing, and final construction.

Engineering choices are adapted to local ground conditions. Footings are set on helical piles, traditional concrete, or American Groundscrew systems, the last designed for mountain-region soil and frost depth. Framing combines wood, composite, and pressure-treated structural lumber, and the company works with manufacturer lines that include Trex, TimberTech by AZEK, Barrette Outdoor Living, and Pergolux.

Around the deck, LVMC Decks builds the structures that complete an outdoor living space, among them pergolas, covered and screened porches, three- and four-season rooms, patios, privacy screens, and outdoor kitchens. The company also provides the landscaping that finishes a project, such as paver patios, retaining walls, and planting, handled by the same team so the deck, surrounding hardscape, and grading are coordinated rather than divided among separate contractors.

LVMC Decks is a family-owned and family-operated deck and outdoor living contractor based in East Stroudsburg and Nazareth, Pennsylvania, serving the greater Pocono Mountains and Lehigh Valley. The company specializes in custom residential and commercial deck construction, with porches, patios, pergolas, and outdoor living spaces built around that core.
