



All Pro Thornton Deck Builders Expands to Commerce City

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All Pro Thornton Deck Builders has extended its residential deck design and construction services to homeowners in Commerce City, Colorado, broadening coverage beyond the company's established base in the northern Denver metropolitan area. The added coverage is now in effect and applies to new deck construction, deck replacement, and related outdoor living projects throughout the Commerce City area. The company has cited rising local interest in backyard renovation as the basis for the broadened coverage.

The expanded service set covers custom deck design, structural framing, railing installation, stair construction, and the repair and restoration of existing decks, including multi-level layouts. Each design accounts for load requirements, drainage, and the orientation of the home relative to sun and prevailing weather. Projects can be built with pressure-treated wood, capped composite boards, or uncapped composite boards, depending on the specifications selected for each site. Permit coordination with local authorities and compliance with current building codes are handled as part of every project.

Work in the newly covered area follows the sequence the company applies across its service region, beginning with an on-site consultation and measurement, followed by design, material selection, and

construction. The consultation covers site grading, access, existing structures, and homeowner priorities for size, height, and intended use. Crews schedule construction in stages so that framing, decking, and railing each pass inspection where required before the next phase begins. Completion timelines vary with project scope, permitting, and seasonal weather, which can compress the building calendar in Colorado during colder months.

The expansion aligns with sustained homeowner investment in outdoor living space across the United States. Industry data indicated that 17.6 percent of newly built single-family homes included a deck in 2023, with an average new-deck size of roughly 309 square feet. Separate market analysis placed United States home remodeling spending near 485 billion dollars in 2025, with an estimated 12 percent of that activity directed toward outdoor projects. Analysts have attributed the resilience of remodeling in part to homeowners electing to upgrade existing properties rather than relocate, a pattern that tends to favor exterior additions such as decks and porches.

"The expansion responds to steady demand from Commerce City homeowners for functional outdoor living space," said David Miller, owner of All Pro Thornton Deck Builders. "Locating deck design and construction within the community supports closer attention to local permitting requirements and site conditions, and it shortens the distance between the crew and the project."

Material preferences in the decking sector have shifted over the past decade, with composite products overtaking treated wood by volume in several United States Census divisions as homeowners weigh maintenance and longevity against upfront cost. Manufacturers have also introduced fire-rated decking lines in response to wildfire-related building standards in some western states. Front porches and ground-level platforms have drawn renewed attention as homeowners look to expand usable exterior space, and both wood and composite options remain available for local projects so that specifications can be matched to budget and upkeep preferences.

Colorado has drawn broader building-products activity tied to outdoor construction, including a November 2025 transaction in which a national distributor expanded its footprint in Colorado and Texas by acquiring a regional supplier of decking and architectural materials. Against that backdrop, the company has framed the Commerce City expansion as a response to local project inquiries rather than a change in its core operations. The Thornton-based firm continues to serve its existing coverage area alongside the newly added Commerce City service.

Homeowners in Commerce City and the surrounding communities can learn more about the available deck services and the boundaries of the expanded coverage. Inquiries from the area are being scheduled alongside existing projects, and the company has indicated that capacity for the expanded territory will be reviewed as demand develops.
