



All Pro Thornton Deck Builders Expands Service Area Across Denver

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All Pro Thornton Deck Builders has expanded its deck design and construction services to serve more homeowners across the Denver, Colorado metropolitan area, widening the range of residential decking projects the company handles throughout the region. The expanded coverage is now in effect, extending service from the firm's base in the north Denver suburbs to additional communities across the metro.

The broadened service area covers new deck construction along with the replacement and repair of existing structures, and it includes work on wood and composite decking, multi-level layouts, railings, stairs, and related outdoor living features. By extending coverage deeper into the Denver metro, the company is positioned to take on projects in neighborhoods that previously sat outside its primary service radius. Scheduling, site evaluation, and permitting support are handled as part of each project.

The expansion comes as national spending on home improvement work remains elevated. Homeowner spending on improvements and repairs across the United States is projected to reach roughly \$518 billion by the end of 2026, according to the Leading Indicator of Remodeling Activity published by the Joint Center for Housing Studies of Harvard University. Outdoor projects such as decks form part of that broader category of

residential investment, which has remained steady even as the overall pace of growth has moderated.

"The expanded service area brings custom deck design and construction to more households across the Denver metro," said David Miller, owner of All Pro Thornton Deck Builders. "A large share of homes in the region were built decades ago, and a growing number of residents are choosing to replace aging decks or add outdoor living space, so the wider coverage lets projects be scheduled across more of the area."

Conditions in the Denver area help explain the focus on residential decking. The median construction year for homes in the Denver metropolitan area is around 1987, and roughly 70 percent of the area's occupied housing units are owner-occupied, according to U.S. Census Bureau data from the American Community Survey. A housing stock of that age commonly reaches the point where original decks need replacement, while owner-occupants are the group most likely to commission such work.

Home values in the region add further context. The median value of owner-occupied homes in the Denver-Aurora-Centennial metropolitan area is about \$631,000, according to U.S. Census Bureau estimates, a level that supports homeowner investment in exterior improvements such as decks, railings, and outdoor living areas. Decks and similar structures also have a finite service life, which sustains ongoing demand for both replacement and new construction in established neighborhoods.

The company has indicated that the expansion centers on its existing decking specialty rather than a move into unrelated construction trades. Materials, structural requirements, and local building codes are addressed on a per-project basis as part of the design and estimate process. "The focus remains on durable materials and code-compliant construction across the larger service area," said Miller.

Deck construction in Colorado is shaped by seasonal weather, with much of the work concentrated in the warmer months of the year. Distributing coverage across a wider portion of the metro is intended to help the company manage project timing and scheduling through the active building season. The expanded area also brings the firm into closer range of permitting jurisdictions across several Denver-area communities, each with its own residential building requirements. Permitting timelines and inspection steps can vary from one jurisdiction to the next within the metro.

Details on the expanded coverage, the range of decking projects handled, and the communities now served are available through the company website, where area residents can learn more. The update applies to residential properties and does not alter the company's focus on deck-related work. The broadened service footprint reflects steady regional demand for outdoor living improvements across the Denver metropolitan area.
