Smith, collected the cheque of \$100,000 on behalf of the school. Crooks Smith is the principal of the school

and recipient of the 2015-16 LASCO-Ministry of Education Principal of the Year Award.

At the end of the event, Day had a special meet and greet session with some of the attendees, including

students from the Allman Town Primary School. During this session, patrons were treated to words of

courage and personal power from Day, who also discussed his bestseller book, ?If Caterpillars Can Fly, So

Can I,? and signed autographs.
