



Gateway Restoration Demonstrates Advanced Thermal Imaging Technology for Non-Invasive Water Damage Detection

"Thermal imaging has transformed how we approach water damage detection," said Danjee Moser, Director of Operations at Gateway Restoration. "In this particular case, the homeowner initially thought they had a minor issue based on what they could see. Our thermal cameras revealed moisture had spread across multiple wall cavities and into the subfloor. This technology allows us to map the complete damage pattern

before making a single cut into drywall."

The advanced detection method represents a significant improvement over traditional moisture detection approaches. By identifying temperature variations caused by evaporative cooling in wet materials, thermal cameras can detect moisture through walls, ceilings, and floors without physical contact. This non-invasive approach saves property owners both time and money by eliminating unnecessary demolition of unaffected areas.

For homeowners wondering how to spot hidden water damage in your home, early warning signs include unexplained musty odors, slight discoloration on walls or ceilings, peeling paint or wallpaper, and increased humidity in specific areas. However, these visible indicators often represent only a fraction of actual water damage occurring within wall cavities and structural components.

The Chandler inspection case highlights a growing challenge in Arizona homes where slow, undetected leaks can cause extensive damage before becoming visible. Temperature fluctuations between seasons, aging plumbing infrastructure, and hard water conditions common in the Phoenix metropolitan area contribute to increased risk of hidden water damage.

"Property owners often don't realize that by the time water damage becomes visible, significant structural damage may have already occurred," added Moser. "Our thermal imaging capabilities allow us to catch these issues early, potentially saving thousands of dollars in restoration costs and preventing mold growth that can develop within 24 to 48 hours of water exposure."
