The firm emphasizes that Georgia's workers' compensation system requires injured employees to report workplace injuries within 30 days and seek treatment only from authorized medical providers. Failure to follow these protocols can result in claim denial, regardless of injury severity.

"The complexity of workers' compensation law means that injured workers face significant disadvantages when dealing with insurance companies alone," added Izquierdo, Jr. "Insurance adjusters are trained to minimize payouts, and they know most workers don't understand their rights or the full value of their claims."

The firm maintains bilingual staff to serve Georgia's Spanish-speaking workforce, ensuring language barriers do not prevent injured workers from accessing legal representation. Operating on a contingency fee basis, the practice charges no upfront fees and collects payment only upon successful case resolution.
