



## **DuraShield Roofing & Contracting President Discusses Industry Standards in Stories from the Roof Podcast**

DuraShield Roofing & Contracting president Anthony Walsh appeared on the Stories from the Roof podcast to share insights on selecting a reputable roofing contractor and building a business grounded in integrity. Hosted by Megan Ellsworth, the episode explores Walsh's journey in the roofing industry and the principles that have guided the company since its founding.

Walsh did not initially plan to own a roofing company. A golf trip with a friend led to a sales position in the sector, where he observed the full project cycle from estimates through completion and the relief homeowners experienced. That exposure shaped his approach. When he established DuraShield Roofing & Contracting in 2003, he took advice from mentors to always do the right thing, own up to mistakes, and correct them promptly. This commitment formed the basis for the company's core values of dependability, integrity, growth, and service.

The conversation highlighted challenges within the roofing sector, including high failure rates for new

companies in the first five years. Walsh attributed many of these outcomes to practices such as failing to follow through on commitments or compromising on quality. In contrast, DuraShield Roofing & Contracting emphasizes long-term thinking, high-quality materials from leading manufacturers, and workmanship that prioritizes customer outcomes. Walsh described experiences of walking homeowners through insurance processes following hailstorms and other weather events, noting the satisfaction derived from resolving complex issues.

"Always do the right thing. So if you make a mistake on a job, own up to it and fix it," said Anthony Walsh, president of DuraShield Roofing & Contracting. "If you always do that, you're doing right by the customer, and that's going to go a long way."

The episode provided practical guidance for homeowners seeking contractors. Recommendations include evaluating how a company defines and lives its values, particularly its willingness to acknowledge and resolve errors. Homeowners should also assess emphasis on quality materials that deliver lasting performance rather than short-term cost savings. Experience with specific regional issues, such as storm damage common in Wisconsin and Illinois, represents another key factor.

Walsh stressed that a roof constitutes a significant investment. Selecting appropriate materials and installation methods can influence property value, insurance considerations, and long-term performance. The discussion underscored the importance of partnering with contractors who maintain transparency and focus on durable solutions.

DuraShield Roofing & Contracting operates as a full-service residential and commercial roofing provider. Services encompass roof replacements, repairs, inspections, and installations of various systems, including asphalt shingles, metal, slate, tile, cedar shakes, and DaVinci composite products. The company also manages storm damage assessments with trained staff who document conditions to support insurance claims. Additional offerings include siding, gutters, and related exterior work.
