This migration clogs the soil and ruins the biological ecosystem required to filter the water safely. Regular servicing removes this accumulated material before it can reach critical levels and cause irreversible damage. When systems are ignored, property owners often find themselves dealing with foul odors, slow drains, and contaminated groundwater pooling in their yards.

Proper scheduling prevents these harsh outcomes and extends the functional life of the entire system.
