



Jump Around Party Rentals Outlines What Families Should Know About Inflatable Safety Before Booking a Summer Party

With birthday season and backyard summer parties in full swing across the Greater Austin area, Jump Around Party Rentals is drawing attention to what goes into preparing an inflatable rental before it arrives at a family's home and why the preparation matters more than most customers realize.

The Round Rock company, which has served families, schools, churches, and community organizations across Travis, Williamson, and Bell counties for years, says the inspection and sanitation process behind each rental is more involved than customers typically expect. William Gann, who owns and operates Jump Around Party Rentals, says transparency about that process has become a priority as the company's service area has grown.

"People see a bounce house and they think it's pretty straightforward," Gann said. "What they don't see is everything that happens before our crew loads it onto the truck. The cleaning, the inspection, making sure

every seam and anchor point is in the right condition. That part is not optional for us."

Every inflatable unit in the Jump Around Party Rentals fleet is cleaned and sanitized between rentals. The company uses commercial-grade vinyl equipment that is free of lead and treated with fire-retardant materials. Gann says those material standards matter not just for safety but for durability. Cheaper consumer-grade equipment degrades faster and is more prone to structural failure under the kind of use a party generates.

Beyond the company's own standards, all inflatable and amusement ride equipment operated in Texas is subject to oversight from the Texas Department of Insurance under the Texas Amusement Ride Safety Inspection and Insurance Act. The law requires operators to carry liability insurance and submit their equipment for annual safety inspections. Jump Around Party Rentals maintains current compliance with those requirements across its full inventory.

Gann said families often do not know the inspection requirement exists, let alone how to verify it before booking with a rental company.

"Texas actually has a pretty strong framework for this," Gann said. "The TDI program exists specifically so that families are not just taking a company's word for it. There is a real inspection process with real documentation. We think customers should ask about that before they book with anyone."

The company recommends that families ask any rental company three questions before confirming a reservation: whether the equipment has passed its current annual TDI inspection, what the company's cleaning protocol is between rentals, and what material standards the equipment meets. Gann said those three questions will quickly separate operators who take the process seriously from those who do not.

Jump Around Party Rentals has published a full bounce house safety guide, covering age limits, wind and heat thresholds for Central Texas summers, anchoring standards, and a pre-event checklist families can print and post at the entrance.

Setup and site conditions are also part of the safety picture. Jump Around Party Rentals crews assess the setup area at every event, anchor equipment according to manufacturer specifications, and brief the customer on supervision guidelines before leaving the site. Gann said the briefing step is one area where he has seen less rigorous operators cut corners.

"The inflatable is only as safe as the event around it," Gann said. "Our crew goes through what to watch for, how many kids should be on it at a time, what to do if the weather changes. That conversation matters. It is part of what we are delivering."

The company serves a service area that now spans Round Rock, Austin, Cedar Park, Georgetown, Leander, Liberty Hill, Hutto, Pflugerville, and Killeen, along with surrounding communities in Travis, Williamson, and Bell counties. Bounce houses, water slides, combo units, obstacle courses, carnival rides, and mechanical rides are all available for birthday parties, school events, church gatherings, and corporate functions.

Gann said summer represents the highest-volume period for the company and also the period when setup conditions require the most attention. Heat affects both equipment and participants, and he said his crews are trained to account for surface temperature, sun exposure, and water management when setting up slides and wet units.
